

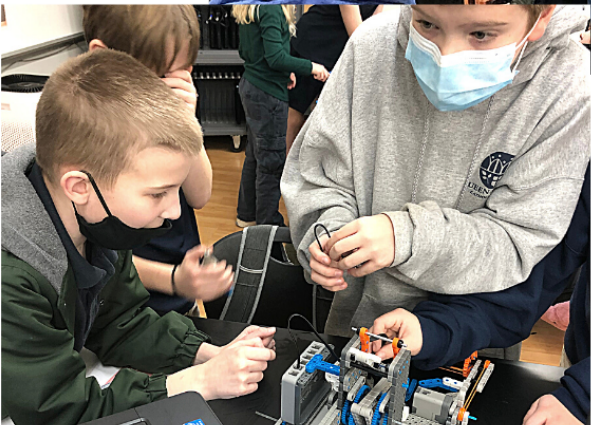
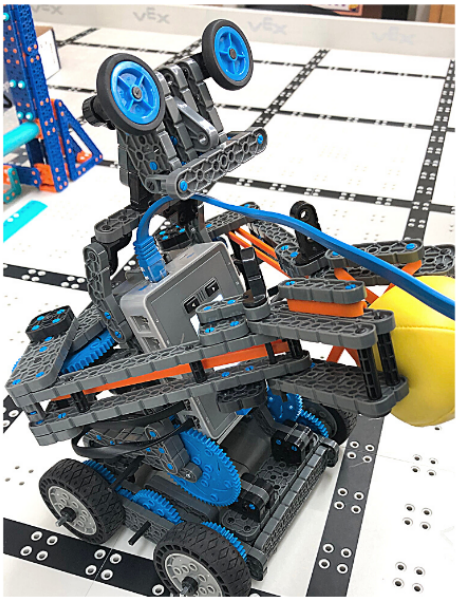

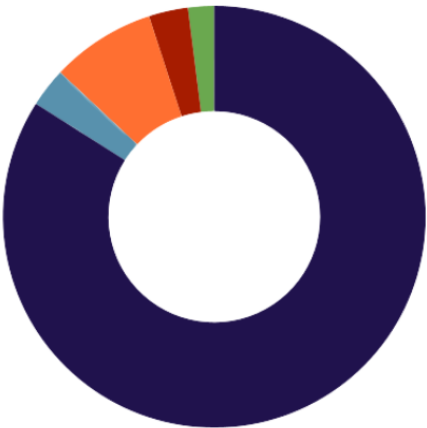
# 2021 ANNUAL REPORT

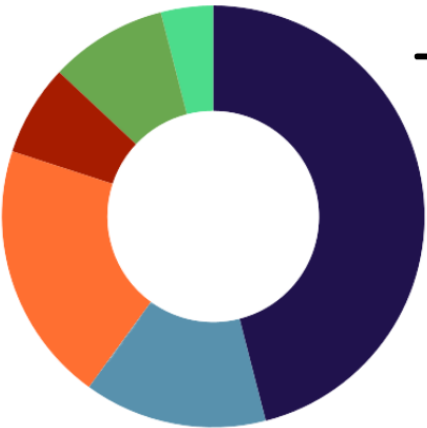
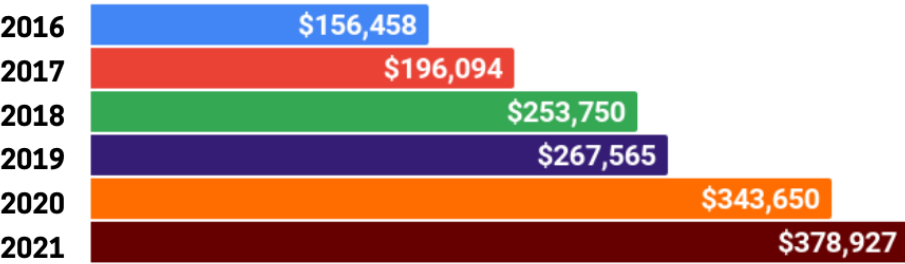

Current enrollment for the 2021-2022 school year is 230 students. This is a number that Queen of Peace has not seen in our 57 year history, making the time ideal to prepare for the increase in capacity and shift in programming. Improved programs and offerings have resulted in steady growth. Our current level of enrollment is almost entirely driven by word of mouth. We think this positive voice in our community, partnered with improvements in STEM programming, environmental education and increased advertising around preschool, will further growth immediately and into the future. - **Indoor Hydroponic Garden and Grow Lights**

- donated by Lettuce Grow and purchased through the Waste Reduction grant
- provides supplemental fresh produce to students at lunch



- **Outdoor Learning Gardens**

- ten raised beds
- composting bins for each classroom

Daily, the students weigh their food waste, document data, and dig their food waste into a raised bed.
