Notre Dame STEM Teaching Fellows

The 2021-2022 school year focused on STEM integration in the classroom. In the fall, students created natural looking prototypes to prevent erosion in the Santiam Canyon following the fires in 2020. In the spring, students built wind turbines to power a generator during a large storm. Over the summer, Jean Craig and Caitlin Smith focused on assessment and feedback for students. They will focus on these during the 2022-2023 school year. Additionally, Craig and Smith are mentoring K-5 teachers at Queen of Peace to implement a STEM integration in the spring 2023.

On Earth Day, April 22, 2022, Queen of Peace School was the only Oregon school to be named a U.S. Department of Education Green Ribbon School. The US department of education GRS is a public engagement initiative structured as a federal recognition award for school sustainability. It is intended to promote state and local collaboration regarding school facilities, health, and environmental education.

What does this mean

Queen of Peace School successfully achieved the award's three sustainability focused pillars. This is measured by reducing environmental impact and costs, improving the health and wellness of students and staff, and providing effective environmental and sustainability education.

Education in Virtue

DISCIPLES OF CHRIST

Queen of Peace School has implemented the Education in Virtues program, which integrates the language of virtue within students' daily lives to promote growth as disciples of Christ. Each month classroom teachers introduce a virtue to students. Additionally, students are introduced to Saints connected to each virtue lesson, followed by a social emotional lesson connecting the virtue of the month, taught by Behavioral Support Coordinator Claire Jones.

Virtuous acts are recognized throughout the month as students learn about saints who are examples of these virtues. When a teacher witnesses a student acting virtuous, the student receives a recognition voucher. Students that have been the most virtuous will be recognized in front of the entire student body at assemblies.

EXPANSION

10,000 SQ FT OF NEW SPACE

Groundbreaking began in late June. The old shed was removed from the school playground and a new shed was built on the north side of the parish. The new structure is insulated and will be a space to park the QP bus, maintenance vehicles and equipment.

Three new classrooms and two single-use bathrooms are being added to the south side of campus, with the intent of becoming preschool classrooms.

On the north side is the addition of a 1600 square

foot STEM lab. This space will open to the courtyard with garage doors to create a very versatile space for environmental education lessons and the collaborative use of technology. Additions across the hall include two classrooms, multi-use and single-use bathrooms and extra storage.

All of these spaces will be ready for students by September 2023.







VENDOWMENT



The school's endowment is completely separate from Queen of Peace School's yearly budget. The endowment interest is restricted and only used for tuition assistance. The OCF Joseph E. Weston Public Foundation Match Grant matches our endowment contributions up to \$45,000 every year.
